## **PURPOSE:**

To help children, youth and families grow in the love and knowledge of Jesus.

## **CHARACTER:**

Loves Jesus, loves his church and his people. Seeks to be filled with the fruits of the Spirit.

## Role:

St Mark's is a church where making Jesus known and growing in him is our goal. We are an Anglican church in the evangelical tradition. We are a growing, multicultural and intergenerational church. Our average attendance across three services on a Sunday is a 170 people. Our Sunday & Milo Club program on Sundays averages about 22 children and young teens. Our Friday Night Youth program has grown and averages about 20 youth each week. The aim for this role is to oversee children – youth, and work with families. The role involves four key areas – Sunday & Milo Club programs, Friday Youth Programs, Weekly Programs, and being a child safe assistant. Our weekly programs have plenty of space for initiative and growth. The role reports through to the Assistant Minister and involves working with a number of volunteers. There is scope for the right candidate to have plenty of vision for how St Mark's is functioning in these areas. The salary range is negotiable depending on the right candidate. 30% of the salary is exempt from tax. St Mark's also provides 5 weeks of annual leave.

Our goal is for this to be a full time position, but we are open to applications for part time – so applying for the role as a youth minister or a children & families minister.
